

Student Lockers

The College of Forestry maintains steel lockers in Peavy 002. These lockers are for student use so that they may keep field clothing, especially boots and rain gear, where they will be handy for field trips.

Students are issued lockers upon request at the instrument room. A roster of assigned lockers and keys issued is kept by the student employees in the instrument room.

Students will be charged \$10.00 for a lost key or a lost lock. These charges will be made to the student's university account. Only College of Forestry locks will be used on student lockers, and a master key is kept in the instrument room for use in an emergency.

Keys will be turned in at the end of each school year, upon transfer to another school or when a student does not intend to return for the following term. Students who do not turn their key in at the time specified above will be charged \$10.00. This charge will be made to the student's university account.

Students are expected to keep their lockers free from flammable or other dangerous material or articles which would result in unusual or offensive odors.
