

### **Emergency Student Loans**

In addition to general loan and grant funds available through the Oregon State University Financial Aid Office, the College of Forestry administers a limited amount of loan fund money through the following program:

#### Gordon and Priscilla Duncan Scholarship-Loan

Interest from an endowment fund established in 1964 by Gordon and Priscilla Duncan, Seattle, Washington. For deserving students in the College of Forestry, preferably in Forest Products, nominated by the college faculty. Selection is based primarily on current need of the student and the student's potential for success, rather than grade point average. Students selected have a moral obligation to repay the loan, without interest, as soon as they are able before or after graduation, based on a negotiated schedule. Approximately \$1,500 - \$2,000 is available in any year.

Students in need should be referred to the office of the Associate Dean for Instruction for application details.
