RE: Recreation use valuation documents

Dear Colleague,

We are developing a publicly available database of economic estimates of recreation use values as part of a broader project\*. Our bibliography of recreation use value documents (n=282) and extended bibliography of screened documents (N=1448) are available at [http://www.cof.orst.edu/cof/fr/research/ruvd/Recreation\\_Bibliographies.html](http://www.cof.orst.edu/cof/fr/research/ruvd/Recreation_Bibliographies.html) for your reference.

We would greatly appreciate your suggestions of additional documents (published or unpublished; peer-reviewed or not; thesis or dissertation) that we should consider including in the database. Our database contains documents from 1965-2003 and we are searching for older and newer documents. Our document screening criteria include:

1. Provides original economic estimate(s) of outdoor recreation activity use value (e.g. consumer surplus, WTP, WTA);
2. Provides an estimate of access value (e.g., per day, per trip, per year] under existing resource conditions at the time of the study; and
3. Conducted in the US or Canada.

We wish to make the database as useful as we can for future research and benefit transfer. Authors may benefit from having documents listed in the database given it increases their visibility and may lead to additional citations.
