- JOB TITLE:** Watershed Technician – Korbel Location (1 Full Time Benefited Position)

- Collect rainfall data, stream discharge measurements and water samples for suspended sediment and turbidity monitoring.
- Conduct analysis of water samples in the laboratory.
- Conduct physical inventories of headwater streams measuring channel dimensions and sediment production.
- Keep legible, accurate notes.
- Enter field data into spreadsheets and databases.
- Active participation in the Company safety program.
- Work in steep and rugged terrain, inclement weather and have tolerance to exposure to poison oak and/or insect bites.
- Assist in other aspects of the aquatic monitoring program as needed.

- Bachelor's degree in hydrology, geology, watershed, or related program.
- Ability to work alone or in small groups without immediate supervision.
- Excellent physical condition and the ability to traverse steep and rugged terrain.
