The Ecological Restoration Institute (ERI) at Northern Arizona University is presently seeking qualified applicants for two full time research technician positions. The ERI, based in Flagstaff, is a national leader in forest restoration ecology, outreach, and education. Duties of these jobs will include collection of ecological data at field sites across the southwestern United States; laboratory work such as preparing plant and soil samples for analysis, dendrochronology; and report writing. Field work will require use of a variety of tools that may include diameter tapes, increment borers, clinometers, and hand held lasers. The ideal candidate will also have working knowledge of laboratory instruments such as microscopes, drying ovens, and litter grinders. Additional duties may include preparation of project summaries, preparation of bibliographies, project documentation, and data organization.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelors degree in biology, environmental science, natural resources, forestry, or similar field; or, four years ecology research or forest field measurement experience; or, an equivalent combination of experience, training and/or education.
