Duties: Conducts the full range of advanced testing, sampling, and data collection/analysis operations and projects. Operates instrumentation and peripheral microcomputers. Ensures compliance with rules or regulatory requirements. Plans, coordinates, and executes data collection activities for ground and surface water, and water quality studies. Extracts information from multiple instruments for analysis. Performs statistical and technical analyses of hydrologic data from a variety of gauging stations. Prepares reports, charts, graphs, and other documentation for highly specialized, multi-variable projects. Prepares monthly and yearly hydrologic reports, water supply papers, water resources investigations that contain research projects, and other special studies. Provides input for the unit land management planning team. Provides input to specific portions of annual program of work. Recommends, prepares or reviews annual operating plans and budgets. Prepares environmental analysis reports regarding natural resources activity. Gathers, compiles and provides data for natural resources databases used as a basis for recommendations to management.
