Schedules daily activities, establishes maintenance schedules, and inspects cleanup operations based on recreation operation and maintenance plans. Reports on conditions and use of sites and areas. Serves as inspector for recreation area cleanup and/or maintenance contracts. Provides detailed information about recreation opportunities to visitors and explains USDA Forest Service rules and regulations. Serves as a Collection Officer and on a regular basis collects fees/envelopes from recreation sites. Patrols District roads and trails and ensures that use is in accordance with District Travel Management Plan and Regional OHV regulations. Assists in maintenance of District recreation facilities such as toilets, road closure gates, water systems, picnic tables, fire rings, barriers, dumpsters and other miscellaneous structures.
