

PWSAC is a private non-profit corporation founded in 1974 by a local commercial fisherman's organization. Our purpose is to optimize the value of the salmon resources produced in Prince William Sound for all user groups. With headquarters in Cordova, Alaska, PWSAC operates four remote salmon hatcheries in Prince William Sound and one on the Copper River system in Paxson. Approximately 600 million salmon fry and smolt are produced each year for release into Pacific waters. The returning adults benefit commercial, sport fishing, personal use and subsistence users.



Qualifications:

Previous hatchery experience and college level schooling in fisheries, biology or related studies preferred but not required.

We have numerous openings each season for Fisheries Technicians positions at our remote salmon hatcheries. Employees get free room and board with wages starting at \$9.00 per hour. We have modern dorm-style living with an on-staff cook. Some of the duties involved are



routine care of incubating eggs, feeding fish, releasing of fish, harvest, taking eggs & fertilizing eggs and general hatchery operations. Position duration ranges from 4 weeks to 4 months, some longer positions are available if you call early. The remote locations of the hatcheries provide ample opportunities for hiking and fishing or just enjoying the beautiful Alaska scenery. Our modern dormitory style accommodations offer many amenities.



There is no deadline to apply. We have positions throughout summer to fill.

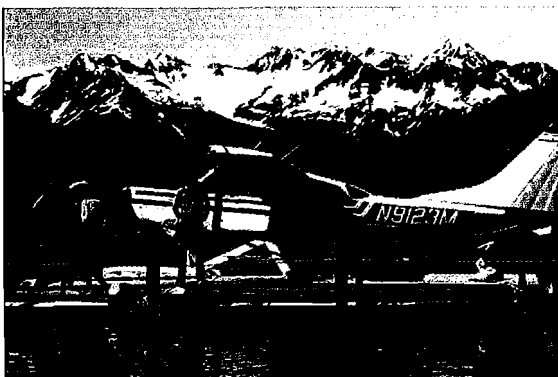

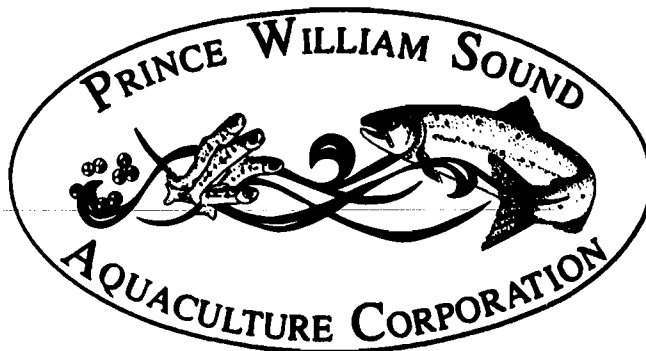
