DUTIES: This position serves as a principal staff assistant to the Forest Recreation, Lands and Heritage Staff Officer with primary responsibility for providing overall long-range leadership, coordination, planning and direction for the Heritage program on the Forest. The position formulates and carries out projects related to stewardship enhancement and public interpretation of cultural resources, including partnership agreements and site stewards programs. Develops, reviews and coordinates the Heritage budget and program of work. In an authoritative capacity, administers agreements with the State Historic Preservation Office, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, other agencies and coordinates with the Tribal Relations Program Manager, on issues related to meeting legal compliance. Ensures that scientific and systematic procedures are followed in identifying, evaluating, and managing cultural resources, including the preparation of maps, inventories, reports, and records related to the discovery, protection, inventory, salvage, and interpretation of cultural resource areas.

TO APPLY: At the close of the outreach period a certificate of candidates will be drawn from the **Open and Continuous** vacancy announcement for the position. FOREST: The Sierra National Forest, located on the western slope of the central Sierra Nevada, is known for its spectacular mountain scenery and abundant natural resources. The Sierra National Forest encompasses more than 1.3 million acres between 900 and 13,986 feet in elevation. The terrain includes rolling, oak-covered foothills, heavily forested middle elevation slopes and the starkly beautiful alpine landscape of the High Sierra. Abundant fish and wildlife, varied mountain flora and fauna and numerous recreational opportunities make the Sierra National Forest an outdoor lover's paradise.

Placed under Federal protection and management in 1893, when the area was designated the Sierra Forest Reserve, these lands have met public needs for wood, water and outdoor recreation for more than a century. Today, the Forest's many rugged wilderness areas makes it one of the most popular National Forests in the United States.

Duty Location: CLOVIS, CA

The population of Clovis is approximately 95,000. It is midway between San Francisco and Los Angeles tucked inside the agriculturally rich San Joaquin Valley. It is easy to find located adjacent to Fresno. There are about 40 churches in Clovis of various denominations. The Clovis Unified School District, one of the highest rated school districts in the State, offers 34 elementary schools, six intermediate schools, and eight high schools. The average cost of a home is \$250,000. Apartments can be rented from \$575 to \$1800 per month. We have 195 sunshine days, 71 partly cloudy, and 99 cloudy. Temperatures in the winter usually range from 36 low to 54 high, though few nights can get down below freezing. In the summer temperatures range from 64 to 97, with several days over 100 degrees.

Fresno is adjacent to Clovis. Its population is approximately 480,000 with a variety of amenities. The average cost of a home is \$230,000. Rental rates range from \$500 to \$1800 a month for 3-bedroom homes and from \$475 to \$1700 for 2-bedroom apartments. Its symphony, local theatre companies, music and dance productions distinguish Fresno as a city with access to a wide variety of cultural events. Fresno Unified School District is the fifth largest district in California which includes Fresno City College, 61 elementary schools, 19 secondary schools, and eight high schools. California State University Fresno is located on Shaw and Cedar, approximately 5 miles from Clovis.
