The USDA Forest Service, Pacific Southwest Research Station plans to advertise for a permanent seasonal 13/13 Data Management Specialist. The Data Management Specialist will be a member of the Wildlife and Watershed Units at Redwood Sciences Laboratory. The unit missions are to improve understanding of the interplay among species, habitat conditions, and resource management at multiple spatial scales and levels of ecological organization and to gain a better understanding of the physical and biological processes that integrate terrestrial, riparian, and aquatic ecosystems at the watershed scale.

The incumbent will provide support and assistance in monitoring, optimizing, and managing database operations and applications using database management tools and utilities. Incumbent develops, monitors, and maintains database management systems (DBMS) environments and objects. Develops, monitors, and maintains Web based applications to improve collaboration with outside partners and cooperators. Uses knowledge of the full range of digital data collection techniques and database principles to support natural resource research. Incumbent will interact with research personnel regarding the structure, scale, and other details of data for each unique research project.

The incumbent will provide support and assists in maintaining an organization's Web site(s) according to predetermined guidelines. Maintains interactive web-based data access as part of a knowledge network. Develops, monitors, and maintains interactive Web based tools to improve data entry, data quality testing methods, and analysis application tools. Edits and tests source code for new web pages. Diagnoses and corrects Web site and application problems.
