well the reason for this email is to let you know about a job opening with the company that I currently work for. I would have email this to Royal Jackson, but from looking around on the COF website, it appears that he is not with the college any longer. Since you were my advisor I decided to send this to you.

I work for a company called Lumbermens underwriting alliance up in Portland. we are an Insurance company specializing in property insurance for the forest product industry. We are currently looking to Hire an appraiser to work out of the portland office (this is the same job that I have). below is the link to the job posting.

Let me give you some more info on this job. We (my department) prepares property appraisals of the buildings and equipment for our insured clients. 90% of these appraisals are for Sawmills, chip mills, plywood plants and planer mills. I travel all over the US and Western Canada doing these appraisals and about 40% of my time is spent on the road. There is very little direct supervision in this job so we are looking for a responsible, mature candidate. We have had trouble filling this position due to the travel requirements, our training program and the fact that the job requires a self motivated person.

here are some skills that would be helpful in this job:

- knowledge of sawmill equipment (maybe worked at a sawmill before)
- any background in the insurance industry
- knowledge of construction (maybe worked for a contractor)
- computer skills/office skills (there is a lot of paperwork that goes along with this job)
- someone able to work with little or no supervision
- someone that is able to be on the road for up to 2 weeks at a time (this is hard for people with small children and families)
- Able to pass very extensive background check and have a clean driving record
