MAJOR DUTIES

Carries out studies based on measurements of the occurrence, distribution, quantity and quality of water within the hydrologic cycle in a geographical and time frame of reference; analyzes the data collected.

Carries out hydrology-related study procedures for assigned projects.

Prepares written and oral reports, and makes suggestions and recommendations for inclusion in reports on hydrological study findings.

Selects appropriate guidelines and determines which legal, regulatory and other requirements apply to the particular situation. Determines appropriate samplings or test procedures.

Participates in the NEPA process as an Interdisciplinary Team member for projects of varying complexity such as, but not

limited to, fuels reduction, watershed restoration, recreation facility enhancement, recreation events, special uses and noxious weed control.
