

Well, it's more of a project than a quiz.

Create a PowerPoint file that contains at least 6 slides. You decide the topic, so it should be a topic that is meaningful or familiar to you in some way. Here are the guidelines for the slides:

_____ You must modify the Slide Master. At a minimum, choose a background color other than white. You might need to adjust the font color too, because you want your text to be readable (light on dark or vice-versa).

_____ One of your slides must contain a picture that is relevant to the slide as well as some bullet points that contain relevant text. The picture must take up at least 6 square inches of the slide area.

_____ One of your slides must be a reused slide. Import (reuse) slide 15 from the file T:\Teach\Classes\FOR112\PPTDesign.ppt. Make this slide the last slide in your file and hide it.

_____ Use appropriate layouts for every slide. If your slide only has a picture on it, then a blank layout is appropriate. The guideline to follow is that no slide should have unused placeholders.

_____ Override the slide master on one of your slides by giving that one slide a different background color.

_____ At least one of your slides should contain Presenter Notes. When you add the notes in the Notes Pane, they should be relevant to the slide.

_____ At least one of the slides should contain a drawing shape. That shape needs to be on a different slide than your picture; but, the shape should be aligned with either the right or left edge of the picture (remember, the drawing guides make this an easy task).

_____ Add an animation for a slide that has bullet points (or multiple objects).

_____ Set your slide show to **Loop Continuously until 'Esc'**. Remember, it's an option found in "Set Up Slide Show" on the Slide Show tab.

_____ Your PowerPoint file will be graded on:

1) the requirements listed above

2) the guidelines we went over during lecture on 10/30/09 (check out the PPTDesign.ppt file in T:\Teach\Classes\FOR112\ for reminders).
